

# Year 3

## Autumn Term 2 Newsletter

<b>English</b>	<p>This term, the children will continue to further develop their writing through the use of fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and powerful adjectives. The children's writing will have a focus on books that link to our history topic on Egyptians. The children will write retells, instructions, setting descriptions, non-chronological reports and winter poems.</p> <p>This half term, 3S are reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes and 3P are reading 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl.</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p>The children will continue to practise adding and subtracting with 2 and 3 digit numbers, including crossing the tens and hundreds. They will do this practically and use the formal column method of addition and subtraction. Then we will start our unit on multiplication and division. They will learn their 3, 4 and 8 times tables. They will use the methods of grouping, sharing and arrays.</p>
<b>Science</b>	<p>The children will be exploring nature in 'Our Changing World' unit throughout the seasons of the year. We will also look at what our bodies need to survive and to be healthy. We will explore the function of skeletons and muscles in the unit.</p>
