

### Year 4

## **Autumn Term 2 Newsletter**

English	In English we will focus on a different stimulus each week that links to a topic that we are studying. We will start with war poetry, followed by a story book that links to our science topic and then we will use our end of day reader ('Varjak Paw') to support our writing. The structure of each week provides the children with the skills they need to complete their independent 'Star Write' on a Friday.
	In guided reading, 4WJ are reading 'Fantastic Footballer' by Jean-Michel Billioud
	and 4C will be reading 'Hugo Cabret' by Brian Selznick. Our end of day reading book is 'Varjak Paw' by SF Said.
Maths	The children will start the half term looking at the area of 2D shapes. We will then spend the remainder of the term focusing on multiplication and division, including the application of times tables up to 12 x 12 and the standard written methods for multiplication and division.
	We will continue to focus daily on times tables and we encourage this to be supported at home.
Science	Human Impact – this unit encourages us to reflect on our actions in terms of the impact that we have on the environment. We'll think about actions such as recycling, building development and habitat destruction.

Subjects	Art – 'Space' will see us looking at how different techniques can help our work appear in three dimensions and depth within an image  French – items of clothing
	<b>RE</b> –animal welfare <b>Geography</b> – in our 'Mediterranean' unit, we will look at countries, climate and cultures in the region
	<b>PSHE</b> – 'Safety First' is a unit where the children will discuss risks in our daily lives and how to manage them
