Year 3

Spring 1 Newsletter

This half term the children are learning to write a setting description based on the book 'River'. The children will write a retell, diary entry and a biography based on the life of Mary Anning. We will also write a non-chronological report based on rivers. The children will
continue to develop their writing skills by using similes, expanded noun phrases and speech.
In maths, we will be continuing to learn about multiplication and division as well as continuing to develop our fluency in our 3's, 4's and 8 times tables. We will be learning about length and perimeter and measuring in metres, centimetres and millimetres. We will be comparing lengths and adding and subtracting lengths.
We will start our new science unit called 'Rock Detectives' where we will learn about different rocks and how they are formed. This half term the children will investigate the hardness and permeability of rocks. They will also start to learn about fossils and soil. The children will find out about 'Our Changing World' and continue to track the changes that they observe outdoors in the school grounds. They will also revisit different trees and plants to see signs of spring.
Below is an outline of the topics that will be covered in foundation subjects: Art – Egyptian art Computing – online safety and Coding Geography – Rivers and UK Geography: The South West History – the Anglo Saxons Music – Sharing Musical Experiences. PE – Egyptian dance and tennis PSHE – Money Matters RE – Sacred Writings French – Colours and Numbers DT – Pop-up books
