English

We will continue to practise reading and writing our names and continue to learn letters and sounds in daily phonics sessions. These will consist of set 1 and set 2 from the 'Read Write Inc Scheme'. We will continue on strengthening fine motor muscles through a range of different activities such as threading, hand warm ups, dough disco and many more in preparation to write. The children are writing CVC words within English and are also writing simple sentences. We will continue to work on this daily.

Please continue to practise reading daily at home - looking at letter sounds and blending them together. It really makes a difference! In addition to this, please look at the book marks within your diary, if you have completed these please request the next colour.

Maths

Our themes in maths this term will be 3D shapes, how many now, manipulate, compose and decompose and to 20 and beyond. This will focus on adding and taking 2 groups, taking away, looking into shape at more depth and exploring tangrams.

Topics

This term we will be covering Kings and Queens as a topic. Through this theme we will focus on the Royal Family, castles and palaces, Coronations, King John and the Magna Carta, and our government. The children will also look at key dates within our community such as the King's Coronation which happened last year. These topics will help children develop the key areas in the EYFS framework: Communication and Language, Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Physical Development, Understanding the World and Expressive Arts and Design.

- **Library** we will start to visit the library this term where will get to choose a book to take home which they can share with you. Please make sure you return this every **Thursday** so they can collect a new book. **We cannot change books on other days due to our library slot.**

 school every day.
