Summer 1 Newsletter

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| English | <p>This half term the children will develop the skills they have already learnt including speech, similes and fronted adverbials. For each unit, the children will be exposed to WAGOLLS (What A Good One Looks Like) and appropriate features for each will be taught. They will be encouraged to 'magpie' ideas for their own writing. Using the book stimulus 'Omar, the Bees and Me', they will firstly retell the story. They will then write a diary entry as one of the characters in the story. After that, we will base our English lessons on another text called 'Arthur and the Golden Rope.' The children will write a setting description, character description and retell. Lastly, they will write an explanation text on how a plant grows. 3S and 3P are both currently reading 'The BFG' and in guided reading, 3P will start to read 'Mr Majeika' and 3S will continue to read 'Bill's New Frock'.</p> |
| Maths | <p>The children will continue to learn about fractions. They will be finding fractions of amounts, learn how to add and subtract fractions, and will solve problems. The next unit will be all about money. They will learn about pounds and pence, adding, subtracting and finding change. We will then move on to learning about time through learning about years, months and hours. The children will also practise telling the time on a clock (both digital and a 24 hour clock).</p> |
| Science | <p>In science lessons, the children are going to be learning about plants. They will learn to identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants. They will explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant. Additionally, they will explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.</p> |
| Foundation subjects | <p><i>Below is an outline of the areas that will be covered in foundation subjects:</i></p> <p>Art – continuing with the Anglo-Saxons and then start looking at 'Architecture' Computing – Coding Geography – South West England History – continuing with the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings and then start looking at 'Law and Power' Music – learning more about different musical styles PE – athletics and gymnastics PSHE – 'It's my Body' RE – Hinduism French – verbs and adverbs relating to movement along with the 'Je Veux Manger' story DT – making bread and butter, and baking a pasta bake</p> |
