## Year 5

## **Summer Term 1 Newsletter**

This half term we are using a range of stimuli to support our 'I'm a Clever Writer' approach in English. We will use the text 'Henry's Freedom Box' to create some emotive poems, 'The Dream Giver' video to write a retell and an Australian Dreamtime story.  We will also have daily guided reading sessions which involve reading with the teacher and completing a range of reading activities about the selected text. In 5W we will continue reading 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty, and in 5CH we will finish 'Street Child' before starting 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. Please encourage your child to read at home at least three times a week to an adult and fill in their homework diaries, which need to come into school every Friday.  This half term children will build on their understanding of shape (including calculating angles), coordinates and translation and calculations involving decimals. Multistep word problems will be incorporated to ensure children can answer these questions in context. This will also help them to prepare for their summer assessments at the end of the year.  We still ask that all children practise their times tables regularly. The expectation in year 5 is that children know their times tables fluently up to 12 x 12.  Forces – children will learn about friction, gravity, air and water resistance.  The Solar System – children will learn about the world beyond our Earth and about different planets and time difference.  History – the Industrial Revolution  Geography – New Zealand  Computing – Coding  French – Building negative sentences using ne and pas, colours, Olympics  PSHE – 'Aiming High' and 'It's My Body'  RE – 'Global Influence'  PE – Indoor PE: dance (production choreography) Outdoor PE: athletics  Production – for the first 3 weeks after the Easter holidays, we shall be rehearsing for our production in the afternoons.
