Attendance update

I am sure many of you have read the increasing number of news articles about school attendance and the rising focus that the government currently has on this area of schooling. At Monkston, we are proactive in our quest to ensure our pupils receive the best quality of education and part of this is regular school attendance. I work alongside Mrs Carr to monitor attendance across the school and where attendance falls below an acceptable level, we have a clear monitoring system for this.



We are proud that our current attendance remains above the national average at 95.7% compared to 94.6% nationally, but we are always striving for this to improve. Did you know that if your child arrives late to school after 9.10am then this will impact their attendance %? Being in school and on time will improve your child's progress and attainment, so working together to improve your child's attendance is a priority for us.

Rewards

As you know, your child is rewarded for every week that they are in school and on time with a raffle ticket. Half termly, we hold a prize draw assembly and at the end of the school year, the prizes get even more special! Our attendance motto is 'be in it to win it'!

Term Time Holidays

I completely understand the frustration of taking holidays during school holiday time due to the increased cost. Whilst the school and governing body have taken the decision not to fine parents for term time holidays, we discourage them due to the disruption this can cause to your child's learning.
