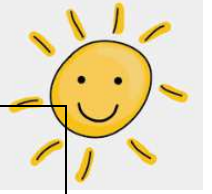
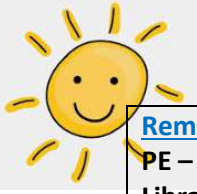
Summer Term 2 Newsletter

English	This term we will be retelling a variety of different stories including 'Tree', 'The Squirrels' Busy Year', 'The Squirrels Who Squabbled', 'The Shepherd Boy' and 'Along the Tapajós'. We will be embedding and consolidating all the skills we have covered in year 1 so far. We will also be improving the children's stamina for writing. Thank you for your continued support in practising reading and spellings every day with your child to support their writing. It really does make a big difference!
Maths	To begin, we will be looking at place value within 100. We will count, compare and order numbers. We will also learn to partition numbers into tens and ones. We will then move onto our unit on money. We will be recognising and counting coins and notes. Finally, we will learn about time. We will recap the days of the week and months of the year. The children will learn to tell the time to the nearest hour and half past. Our reasoning and problem solving skills will continue.
Science	In science we will be looking at plants that we have grown and what foods can be made from them. We will be observing seasonal changes, including what we might wear, and what has changed in the environment around us.
Foundation Subjects	History - our theme is 'Parliament and Prime Ministers'. We will be learning about the role of a Prime Minister and what Parliament entails. Art - we will be looking at sculpture, including 3D art and making models using clay and plaster. RE - we will be learning about what rituals are and how they differ from routines. We think about non-religious festivals they do every day. Children explore the rituals associated with prayer for Muslims, worship for Hindus and Holy Communion for Christians. PSHE – our unit is about 'Aiming High'. We will be talking about their qualities and what they would like to achieve in the future.
Activity Passports	The children have started to complete their Activity Passports and, so far, they have made a class collage, had fun identifying sounds in a sound quiz, designed a new front cover for a book and performed in front of the class. Well done and a huge thank you for completing activities at home – just make sure to sign and date the passport for your child - the final projects from home are due in to school by Friday 27th June .
