Summer Term 2 Newsletter

English	In English, we will be inspired by the stories of Anthony Browne. Later in the term, we will be using the 'Little People, Big Dreams' books to help us write biographies and recounts linking to our history lessons. We will continue to practise the grammar skills required in year 2 including using apostrophes for contractions or apostrophes for possession. Please continue to listen to your child read out loud at least four times a week to help with their understanding of vocabulary and inference skills.
Maths	In maths we will consolidate our learning from earlier in the year. This will include place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will also learn about how to present simple information in pictograms and bar charts. By the end of year 2, the children should know how to count in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. They could use their Times Table Rockstars account to practise this as this will be part of their homework in year 3. Over the summer holidays, the children could also practise telling the analogue time to 5 minutes.
Science	In science we will continue learning about plants. We will discuss how plants grow in hot, dry or cold places. We will also be looking at the lifecycle of a butterfly and watching our class caterpillars grow releasing them once they've developed into butterflies. We will also revise some other topics from this year such as materials and animals including humans.
