

# Year 4

## Summer Term 2 Newsletter

<b>English</b>	In English we will be writing a diary about The Great Fire of London to tie in with our history topic. Later in the term we will be writing setting and character descriptions based on the text called 'The Last Wolf'. The children will continue to develop their use of expanded noun phrases, figurative language (similes & metaphors) and a wide range of conjunctions to extend their ideas while making their writing more interesting to read. We will also continue to have a focus on handwriting. In guided reading 4CW are reading 'Fantastic Footballers' and 4P will continue to read 'The Invention of Hugo Cabret'.
<b>Maths</b>	Shape – we will learn about the different types of triangles and how to measure them accurately, as well as identifying lines of symmetry. Statistics – children will learn to read and interpret line graphs. Position and Direction – we will learn to plot co-ordinates and translate point across a grid.
<b>Science</b>	In science this half term the children will be learning about different habitats. The children will build on their knowledge of animal groups, focusing on common carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. They will then look at the impact humans have upon different habitats. The children will also learn that humans can have both a positive and negative impact on these habitats. Next, they will construct a classification key using the characteristics of plants they might find in the local environment.
